INFORMAL NOTES FROM PCC

August 2018

The PCC met for the second time this year, on 16th May. After formal business we heard reports from various committees including:

Worship – They had spoken about Remembrance Sunday, among other Services, as it is 100 years since the end of WWI this year. The Church of England has released literature on this and there is also another national initiative on it entitled “There but not there”.

We are hoping to have a normal morning service and a special service in the afternoon/evening with poetry and music, as well as a Remembrance Book for people to record tributes to relatives who served in the First World War, or the other fallen heroes.

Fabric – The gutters on the Walderslade Road side have been cleared again and the heater at the back of Church has been repaired. Also the water heater in the Pastoral Room has been repaired, thanks to a donation.

Building – The Building work will start on 23rd July and end on 31st August. The Playgroup store will be cleared once they have broken up for the summer and the contents put upstairs in the Balcony and at one end of the hall. The Office will be moved to the other end of the hall while all the work is carried out. The toilets, cisterns and taps will be replaced in the Annexe toilets. The Welcome Area will be repainted and new notice boards put up outside. The workmen will be on site from 7.30 am to 4 pm daily and the Pastoral Room is out of bounds during this time, as it is the workman's base. There will obviously be restricted access in the hall and other areas.

The Church's website is in the process of being restructured.
